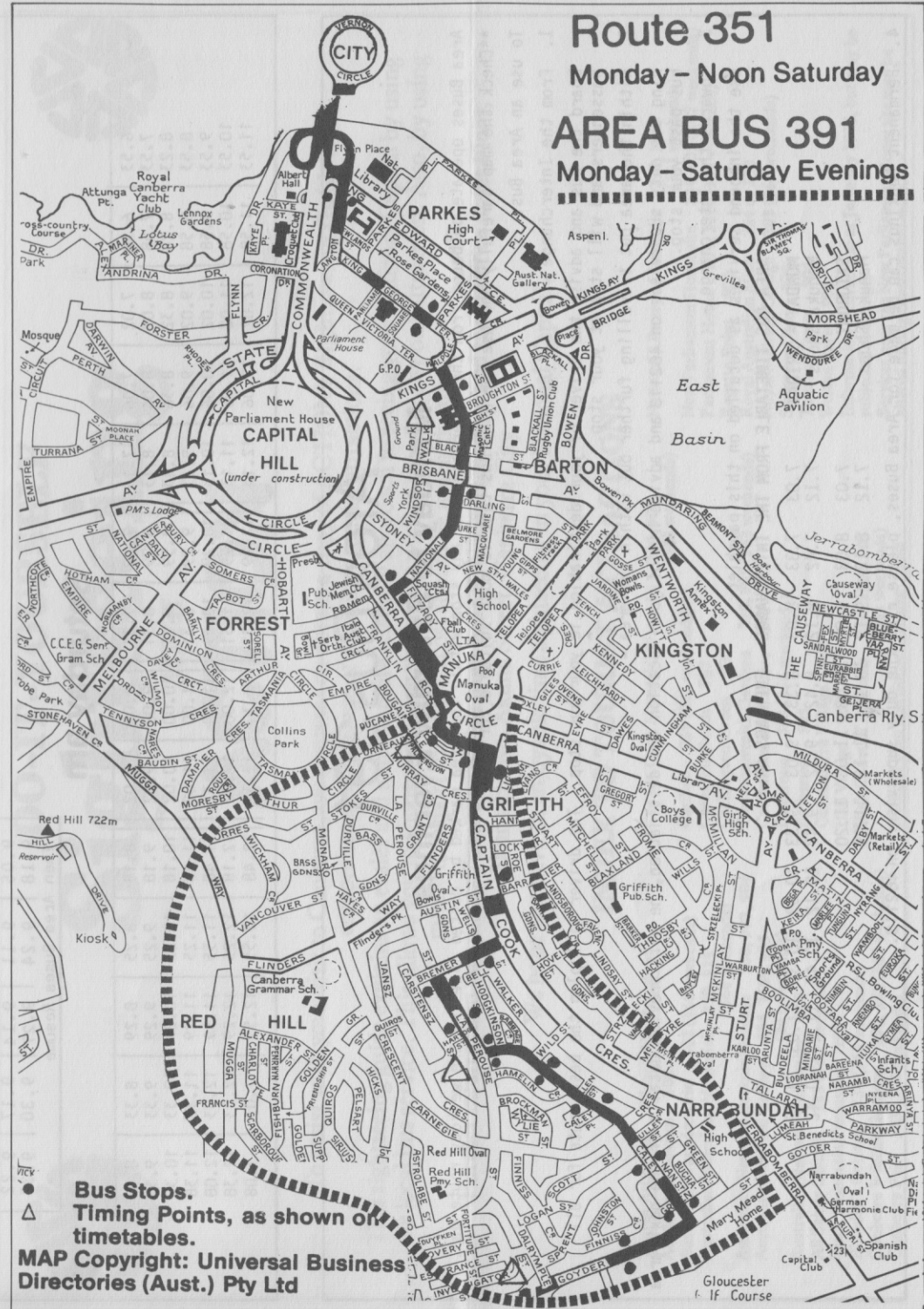

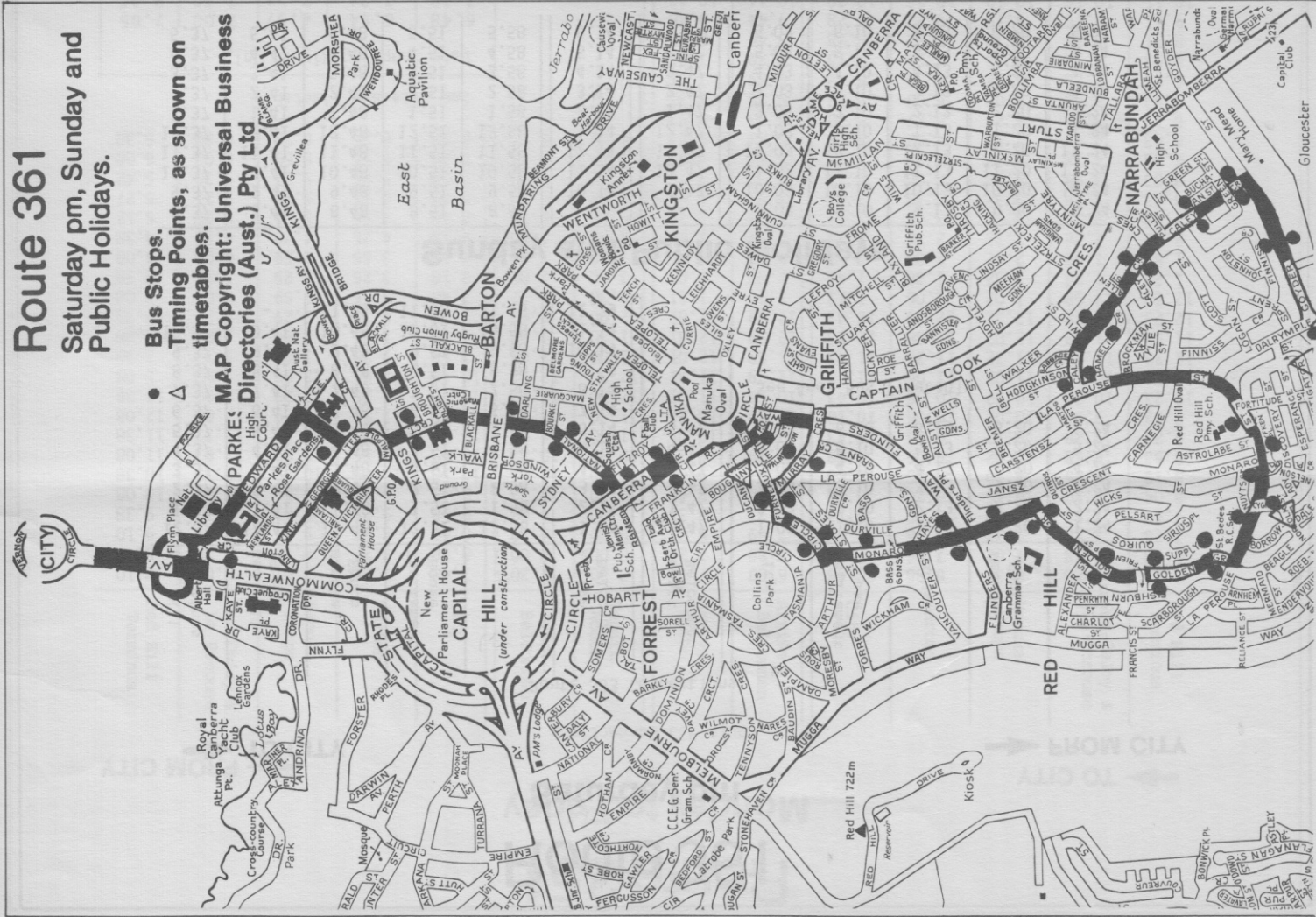

Area Bus 391

Monday to Saturday Evenings

Area Buses operate outbound from the interchange to any stop within the area marked by dotted lines on the weekday route map.

**Check the map carefully and use the Area Bus that is most suitable for you.

To use an Area Bus:

1. From the Interchange -

board the bus and advise the driver of your destination ie your bus stop. The driver will plan the best route for all passengers and will stop at your stop.

2. Within the area but travelling further out within the area -

ring the duty supervisor on 462113 and advise him of your location and destination, he will provide details of the next area bus past your stop.

3. Towards the Interchange -

use the inbound services as detailed on this pamphlet.
