All times referred to in this planner are times the bus will leave and arrive back at the Jolimont (Tourist Bureau) Terminal. Details of arrival and departure times at points of interest included on ACTION Sightseeing Specials are shown inside each timetable.

**Example:**  
Catch the 10.12 am trip to **Red Hill** (Route 905) returning at 11.40 am; then get the 12 noon **The Tower** (Route 904) which returns at 1.13 pm. Have a quick snack at Jolimont before going on **The Cotter** at 1.35 pm. This bus arrives back at Jolimont at 4.53 pm.

### Day Tripper Tickets

- The Visitor Information Centre, Northbourne Avenue — near Morphett St (Monday– Sunday)

### Route 905

#### Regatta Point Exhibition

The Regatta Point Planning Exhibition, presented by the National Capital Development Commission, depicts Canberra's development by means of maps, models, audio-visual displays and photographs. An ideal start to your Canberra sightseeing.

#### Embassies

Over 60 countries have diplomatic representation in Canberra, bringing an extraordinary variety of national architectural styles. Special exhibitions are open to the public at the Papua New Guinea and Indonesian delegations. The bus waits at both these missions if required.

#### Red Hill Lookout

This affords excellent views of South Canberra and Woden Valley. For your convenience, the bus waits at the lookout if required. There is a restaurant and kiosk at the summit.

#### Manuka Shopping Centre


One of Canberra's oldest shopping centres, it has many specialty shops. If you alight here, you can return to the City on a route 350 or 351 bus in Franklin Street (opposite the Cinema) every 15 minutes.

#### New Parliament House

The present Parliament House, opened in 1927, was always intended to be temporary and is no longer adequate. The new building is due to open for Australia's Bicentenary in 1988. You can get off the bus here and inspect the exhibition or view the new building from the observation platform. Refreshments are available. At your own leisure, walk a few hundred metres north, towards the City, to Brisbane Avenue where you can get a route 234 bus back to the City (passing this stop at 08 and 38 minutes past each hour).

#### Parliament House

You can alight here and visit the present Parliament House, or walk down towards the Lakeshore to the High Court and National Gallery. Any bus marked 'City Interchange' will return you to the City.

### Departure points:

All buses depart from Bay 8, Jolimont Coach Terminal at the rear of the Canberra Tourist Bureau in Northbourne Avenue and then two minutes later from Bay 2, City Interchange, East Row outside Youngs Store.

\* There are no ACTION services on Christmas Day, New Year's Day or Good Friday.

\* Route 905 does not operate on Public Holidays.

† Routes 350 and 351 operate every 15 mins on weekdays only. On Saturday morning Routes 350 and 351 operate from the Manuka Shops at 02 and 47 minutes past the hour. On Saturday afternoon Route 361 operates from the Manuka Shops every hour at 48 minutes past the hour.

‡ Route 234 operates weekdays only. No service operates on weekends.

• City to Red Hill Lookout is a two section trip.
