**LEISURE ROUTE INFORMATION**

1. National Botanic Gardens - These gardens are devoted almost exclusively to Australian Flora. There are numerous marked trails through the gardens and a display area and bookshop. Open daily 9.00-5.00pm.  
 Facilities - Toilets, kiosk, picnic tables, wood barbeque (adjacent to the gardens); drinking water.
2. Black Mountain Peninsula - Sand beaches and safe swimming in a pontoon area are features of this large popular parkland on the Lake Burley Griffin foreshore. Children's play equipment is also provided. Open at all times.  
 Facilities - Gas barbeques, picnic tables, toilets, drinking water, swimming and children's playground.
3. Scrivener Dam - Built in 1963, the dam holds back the water of the Molonglo River to form Lake Burley Griffin. From here you can walk to the lookout for a view of Government House, Yarralumla and gardens.  
 Facilities - Toilets, picnic area.

Picnic Advice

**Fire Precautions** - Fires should only be lit in designated fireplaces. During total fire bans no barbeque - wood, gas or electric - may be used. Such bans are advertised on radio and in the press.

**Gas and Electric Barbeques** - These units are provided at many urban sites. The temperature is pre-set and requires no adjustment. Gas barbeques accept 10¢ coins, and electric barbeques 20¢. Between 20-40¢ should be enough for an average family meal.

**Litter** - Pleasant picnic sites quickly become degraded if all users fail to control litter. Please place all litter in the bins provided. Annual litter collection costs in Canberra are considerable and your assistance will help to reduce these costs substantially.
